Workload in these departments is also very heavy, since there is insufficiency of staff at higher level. To overcome these difficulties/problems, Principal & Controlling Officer, Government Homoeopathic Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram has forwarded proposals for creation/upgradation of some teaching posts in Government Homoeopathic Medical Colleges in the letters read as second paper above.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the upgradation of two posts of Reader each in Departments of Pharmacy Practice of Medicine in Government Homoeopathic Medical College. Thiruvananthapuram and Kozhikode and one post of Reader in Department of Repertory in Government Homoeopathic Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram to the post of Professor.
