5) Dr.V.G.Udayakumar, Vice President, Council of Indian System of Medicine raised the issue of exemption from Registration given to Pramparya Ayurveda Vaidyans and Homoeopathy Practitioners having no recognized qualifications in the Districts of Palakkad, Malappuram, Kozhikkode, Wayanad, Kannur and Kasaragode as ordered in the G.O(MS)No.114/11/H&FWD Dated 21-2-2011. The council is of the opinion that the G.O is against the provisions of the Central Council of Indian Medicine Act, 1970 and the Homoeopathic Central Council Act, 1974. Further, as there is sufficient number of qualified practitioners in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy, the Government order is against Section 38 of the Travancore – Cochin Medical practitioners Act 1953 it self.

Therefore, the Council unanimously resolved to request the Government to reconsider the issue and, if necessary, issue orders as recommended by the committees constituted by the Government for the above purpose.
