With reference to your letter cited I am to inform you as follows.

As per para 11 (a) of G.O.(P) 89/P&ARD dated 22.5.89 Employees who are physically handicapped, relatives of Jawan, Inter-caste married and SC/ST shall not ordinarily be transferred until they complete 5 years of duty in a station. Even after completion of 5 years of duty transfer should be resorted to only to provide employee belonging to the same priority category (vide G.O.(P) 17/90/P&ARD dated 25.5.1990). Hence a physically handicapped employee can be transferred out only to provide a physically handicapped employee.

There are only 3 Senior Superintendents in the two RKM Govt. Homoeo Medical Colleges (one SC, one PH and one other category) Hence if the conditions regarding transfer as per GO(P) 17/90/P&ARD dated 25.5.90 is made applicable, no body could get a chance for transfer as per their request. No guidelines have been issued from Government regarding the procedure to be adopted in such a circumstance.

In the above circumstances no intervention of Government is necessary in this case.
