Sub:- Scheme for Central Nomination to Bachelor in Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery (BAMS), Bachelor in Unani Medicine & Surgery (BUMS), Bachelor in Siddha Medicine & Surgery (BSMS) and Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) Courses.

Sir,

You are aware that there is resurgence of interest in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha & Homoeopathy medicine in India and abroad. The strength of these systems in treating common as well as chronic diseases, their cost-effectiveness, safety and nearly no adverse side effects due to largely plant based drugs have greatly contributed to their development and popularity. Central Government has been striving hard to promote these systems of medicine. In this context seats are being allotted to students of the States/UTs for studying BAMS/BSMS/BUMS and BHMS, where the college of the respective system is not available.

2. The seats earmarked by various colleges have been given in Annexure. In supersession of previous orders issued by this Department, the following guidelines have been framed to utilize the seats by further earmarking for utilization by State Governments/Union Territory Administration, where such facilities are not available: --

- I. The State Governments/UTs will invite applications from the interested candidates for selection for nomination to degree courses by a stipulated date.
- II. The nomination will be forwarded to the concerned colleges/ Directorate of ISM&H of States/Union Territories as stipulated in the prospectus released every year by the college authorities by the end of June every year.
- III. The college authorities will fill up the seats by the candidates in the waiting list, in case the State Govt./UT fail to nominate their candidates. For this

purpose, the colleges will address the State Governments/ U.Ts for whom the seats have been allotted by the college/this Department to sponsor their suitable candidates for the said seats, under intimation to this Department.

IV. The college authorities would admit students sponsored by State Government without taking any admission tests subject to fulfillment of qualifying eligibility criteria.

3. The State Governments are requested to utilise the slots made available by recommending suitable candidates for admission to degree courses to the Colleges allotted to them under intimation to this Department.

4. The orders shall remain valid for subsequent academic years unless modified or amended.

Sub:- Scheme for Central Nomination to Bachelor in Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery (BAMS), Bachelor in Unani Medicine & Surgery (BUMS) and Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) Courses.

Sir,

You are aware that there is resurgence of interest in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha & Homoeopathy medicine in India and abroad. The strength of these systems in treating common as well as chronic diseases, their cost-effectiveness, safety and nearly no adverse side effects due to largely plant based drugs have greatly contributed to their development and popularity. A number of foreign countries have evinced keen interest in our Systems and foreign students are approaching our institutions for admission in Under Graduate courses.

2. The education in colleges of Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy is being regulated by the Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM) and Central Council of Homoeopathy (CCH) respectively. Five-and-a-half year Degree Course including one year internship is being conducted at the colleges set up by Central/State Governments and NGOs. The standard of education are being monitored by the above statutory councils (CCIM and CCH). Some colleges of Ayurveda, Unani and Homoeopathy have earmarked seats in Degree Courses of BAMS, BUMS and BHMS for foreign students.

There are 4 seats available for foreign nationals under self financing scheme as per Annexure I. The students nominated under this scheme will have to bear the expenses on boarding, lodging, education and other day to day requirements from their own sources. The Central Government will not bear any expenditure on any account on the education of foreign students.

4. For utilization of seats earmarked by various colleges for foreign students, the following guidelines will be followed for nomination against such seats :-

I.The applicant should possess minimum qualification prescribed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine / Central Council of Homoeopathy for admission to such degree courses;

II.The application must be recommended by the Government of the concerned country to Ministry of External Affairs through Indian Missions/Embassies in the respective country who in turn may send them to Department of ISM&H with their endorsement of NOC.

III.The nomination should be received in the Department by the end of May every year. Nomination received after closing date for admission are liable to be rejected.

IV.Thereafter, the Central Government in the Department of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy will process the proposal for forwarding their applications to the College (as opted by the foreign students) after taking clearance from Ministry of External Affairs and Home Affairs.

5. Indian Missions abroad are requested to give wide publicity to the above scheme for availing of education in Ayurveda, Unani & Homoeopathy in India.

2. Apart from the above mentioned 4 seats under self financing scheme, 20 seats(Annexure-II) have been reserved for the students of BIMSTEC countries namely Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Thailand under UG course. Indian Council for Cultural Relation, Ministry of External Affairs, Azad Bhawan, Indraprastha Estate, New Delhi is nodal agency for nominating candidates against these 20 seats. ICCR is providing a scholarship for these 20 candidates of BIMSTEC countries. Application for nomination against these seats may be forwarded to ICCR directly.

Sub:- Central Nomination to M.D.(Ayurveda/Unani/Siddha) Courses

Sir,

In supersession of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 23rd March, 2004, it has been decided that following guidelines may be followed for nominations against seats allotted to State Governments/UTs under Central Pool :-

- 1.1 Candidates sponsored by the State/UT Governments from States/UTs which do not have colleges, offering PG level education in the Specialities concerned will be considered for nomination as Govt. of India nominees for M.D. courses against the seats earmarked by the donor institutes/colleges for Govt. of India's nominees.
- 1.2 While making nomination against Govt. of India's nominees; preference will be given to regular teaching staff of any Govt. run medical institution. If no teaching staff of State Govt. run medical institution is available for nomination, Medical Officers working in the Govt. will be nominated as Govt. of India nominees. If neither a teacher nor a Medical Officer working in the Govt. is available for nomination, private candidate sponsored by the State Govt. will be considered for nomination.
- 1.3 Nominations by the State/UT Govt. must be sent to the Central Govt. and the respective institute /college before closing date for receipt of applications for admission to PG courses. Applications received after closing date are liable to be rejected.

- 1.4 The nominee of Central Govt. shall not be subjected to the entrance test conducted by the Institute/college. They would be qualified for the selection on the basis of passing the qualifying Degree level course in respective system.
- 1.5 No “sponsored” candidate in the employment of the State Government will be paid any emoluments by the institution during such training period. Payment of any remuneration in this regard will be the responsibility of the State concerned.
2. The details of seats made available for nomination under Central Pool have been listed in the Annexure-I
3. For sponsoring candidates for Central Pool all the State/UT Governments may follow following guidelines:-
 - 3.1 All the State/ U.T Governments which do not have colleges offering PG level education in the Specialities concerned are requested to take steps to sponsor their candidates in time.
 - 3.2. While selecting the candidates priority may be given to the regular teaching staff of the State Government run medical institution. In case no teaching staff of State Government’s run medical institution is available for sponsoring, Medical Officer working in the State Government may be sponsored. If neither a teacher nor a medical officer working in the Government is available, private candidate may be sponsored by the State/UT Government.
 - 3.3 Applications of all the sponsored candidates finalized by the State/UT Governments may be sent to the Secretary to the Government of India, Department of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy by 31st May, 2005.
 - 3.4 All the applications may be sent simultaneously and not separately, in the enclosed proforma (Annexure-II) duly filled in within time. Incomplete application will not be accepted.
 - 3.5 It may also be certified by the State/UT Government that the specialities for which the candidate has applied for is not available in any recognized (Government/Private) institute/college of that State/UT.

4) This Department will scrutinize and finalize the nomination by 30th June, 2005. Teaching institutions which have earmarked seats for utilization by this Department, will send prospectus/Information Bulletin to this Department immediately on its publication and sale to the applicants seeking admission to the M.D. courses. The teaching institutions will fill up the seats earmarked for Central Government nominee only after getting the direction from this Department.

2. The education in colleges of Ayurveda, Unani & Siddha and Homoeopathy is being regulated by the Central Council of Indian Medicine(CCIM) and Central Council of Homoeopathy (CCH) respectively. Five-and-a-half years Degree Course, including one year internship is being conducted at the colleges/institutions set up by Central/State Governments and NGOs. Three years P.G. course leading to M.D.(Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy) is also being conducted at selected institutions. 3. There are 16 seats available for foreign nationals under self financing scheme as per Annexure I. The students nominated under this scheme will have to bear the expenses on boarding, lodging, education and other day to day requirements from

their own sources. The Central Government will not bear any expenditure on any account on the education of foreign students.

4. For utilization of seats earmarked by various colleges for foreign students, the following guidelines will be followed:-

- I. The applicant should possess minimum qualification prescribed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine / Central Council of Homoeopathy for admission to Post Graduate courses;

Thereafter, the Central Government in the Department of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy will process the proposal for forwarding their applications to the College (as opted by the foreign students) after taking clearance from Ministry of External Affairs and Home Affairs.
5. Indian Missions abroad are requested to give wide publicity to the above scheme for availing of education in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy in India.
6. Apart from the above mentioned 16 seats under self financing scheme, 9 seats(Annexure-II) have been reserved for the students of BIMSTEC countries namely Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Thailand under PG course. Indian Council for Cultural Relation, Ministry of External Affairs, Azad Bhawan, Indraprastha Estate, New Delhi is nodal agency for nominating candidates against these 9 seats. ICCR is providing a scholarship for these 9 candidates of BIMSTEC countries. Application for nomination against these seats may be forwarded to ICCR directly.
